You will have a working agreement with a team from the NBA Major League. You must be reliable and own either BLM, Negamco, or Strat-o-Matic baseball. Also send your past table gaming experience with your application.

(ED) Information on clubs and their results come in to ASD infrequently. Presidents, please have your member responsible for information and statistical compilation keep ASD informed of club progress.

I've been playing Negamco Baseball since 1963 when I was 11 years old. Before this year I always had the problem of completing a standard league season without being pressed for time or being bored by meaningless games between last place teams down the stretch. This year, I devised a relatively simple method of playing a league and avoiding these problems. My method also creates more excitement then standard leagues and I think it is worth sharing.

It is a single elimination tournament set up with all 24 teams. The teams can be seeded for byes and opponents or their positions can be determined randomly. Each team plays a best 2 of 3 series with their opponent. The winner advances into the next round.

Instead of just a plain elimination tourney, divisional and league standings are kept on a point system. One point is awarded for each victory in the 1st round, 2 points for a win in the 2nd and so on. To add a little divisional and league flavor and extra bonus point is awarded for each win over a team in the same league and 2 bonus points for each win over a team in the same division. In the case of 2 game sweeps a team is awarded the equivalent # of points as 3 victories plus any bonus points.

Ex. In 4th round if team A took 2 of 3 games from team B and they were in the same division team A would be awarded 12 points(4 points for each win and 2 bonus points for each win). Team B gets

6 points(4 points for the win, 2 points bonus). Team A advances. B is out.

It is extremely exciting for a team to be able to come out of nowhere by winning 6 of 8 in a row while the division leader gets knocked off. Also there is no prescribed number of games that must be played. If one tourney is finished and there is time another and another can be played and the wins and losses and points are just added to the standings. Teams do not play the same number of games but they all start out with the same possibilities, and it will be the better teams that play the greater number of games.

Last month, December 1970 issue, we began a series, team by team, on 1970 baseball line-ups and statistics for every player who played during the 1970 baseball season. Not all the players' statistical results are given, but the major categories are listed. One very important section is the games played by position. This helps evaluate the importance of each player and for table gamers it gives them actual information to go by in replaying the 1970 season.

Here are the meanings of each abbreviation: # is an assigned uniform number for each player. GP is Games Played. POS is Position. F is a fielding rating. T is a throwing rating. PH is the number of Pinch Hits(or pinch run appearances). AB is at bats. H is the player's hits. R is the player's runs. HR is the player's home runs. RBI is the player's runs batted in. BA is the player's batting average. PITCHERS' ABBREVIATIONS: SG is Starting Games. RG is Relief Games. F is fielding rating. CG is Complete Games. W is Wins. L is Losses. S is Saves. IP is Innings Pitched. H is Hits Allowed. ER is Earned Runs Allowed. R is Runs Allowed. HR is Home Runs Allowed. BB is Walks Allowed. SO is Strikeouts Allowed. ERA is Earned Run Average.

We suggest you keep this roster-statistical section of ASD for future reference, and that you also obtain the December, February, and March issues to complete the 24 team set.

Enclosed you will find an original of my revisions to your BLM defensive adjustments. I do believe they reflect a far more accurate reading of the actual statistics than BLM's research director has accomplished.

Harry Conover and I have become very close friends(practically in daily communication) and it was he who pointed out the errors. When I started putting my mind to it I believe I found the appropriate solutions. Compare for example how generally consistent they are

with the basics of each category. If you look especially carefully, you will note that the information provided(at a cost) to BLM fans, was inaccurate- just on a logical comparison.

Harry has also explained to me his interpretation of the problem the game companies are having with the players association and its royalty demands. Can't you bring it out in the open and get your readers' views? If you do not I am afraid that the alternatives will not

only hurt the companies and their production, but frustrate an awful lot of innocent fans who enjoy playing the games. Your advertisements and general public relations(if you can call it that) if you will forgive me, frankly stinks. BLM has had years to expose a great product, but each year they seemingly have backed more and more away!

Jets-36, Giants 19

You might find it of interest that my two fanatical sons(2 of 4 boys, there are also 2 girls) aged 8 and 7 have actually been playing a very sophisticated BLM Football game. Their first experimental game was amazing(I am sorry I did not maintain 1st half statistics). The Jets vs the Giants. In the first half the Giants led 16-5, Namath not completing a pass beyond ten yards until the last attempt of the half. Tarkenton kept successfully hitting Frederickson as observed a few weeks before on TV(even with a rather poor rating). In the second half Namath hit Maynard for an 80 yard TD, Sauer twice, and Shell once for 24 yards(TD) and stymied the Giants for a 36-19 finale. That year, they actually only played an exhibition game which the Jets won 37-14!!!

KC 20, Vikings 16

In a similar replay of the Super Bowl (IV), KC came from behind to defeat the over-lauded Vikings 20-16. The only consolation to the twice defeated "older" and more effectively logical play selecting son, was the fact that he did better than poor ol' Bud Grant (23-7). By the

way, he also lost his QB, Kapp in the second half! He had an unbelievable streak of good numbers, but very bad resulting plays...on any given day....

Albert M. Simon, Old Bridge, NJ
(BLM Research Director) Very interesting. Readers should try both charts following rules given and then report their play telling of the differences because of the differences in the 2 charts. I would like to have Al write telling me why he rated in this manner. The cold figures do not tell much..an explanation of his method would be helpful. The XRB differences could be explained either because I made a mistake, or a difference in interpreting how to use the rule for the adjustment rating. The charts are a reversal of each other. Most of the other differences are created by the maker's method of rounding fractions and minute subjective judgments. Those 1 point differences probably would be resolved by utilizing a uniform method of rounding fractions. (Ed) I appreciate the work done on this chart- it fits ASD's concept of coverage. Thanks, Al Simon.

The players association has the legal and economic power to force any game company to meet their demands or cease using their members' names. Depending upon their attitude, they may attempt to control the use of all baseball material by continuous lawsuits which the companies can not afford or to wage a campaign to get other associations to make similar demands. In either case the small, low volume, specialty company would be economically strangled.

As long as the association can sell their endorsement and members' names

for advertising purposes they will not allow anyone to use members' names without their controlling that use. I do not think we can legally alter their power to do so. Big League Game Company spent thousands of dollars fighting them on this and lost. A person could feel strongly about this and take some action. The Federal Trade Commission regulates advertising. A person could easily believe that using public figures to advertise products is wrong! It adds to the price tag of the product. It misleads people about products. If successful it creates unfair competition and monopoly situations. Writing to the FTC (if done by enough people) could eventually lead to the banning of all testimonials and endorsements by "public persons" and thus with the profit motive gone the players and the association would again no longer care who uses information which presently can be controlled by the association but which is by its very nature essentially public information.

The FTC, and the Toy Association's self-regulating committee on TV advertising in actions taken last fall have already begun to challenge this reprehensible practice, but as you know without public support these groups may let the practice continue out of sheer indifference.

The Big League Game Company personnel are not very good salesmen. They do not have the financial resources for a public relations campaign. Their concern is not in promoting their products, but in maintaining good relationships with each and every one of their customers.
