



PTG. like Negamco and BLM, does not set itself up as a judge of the quality of professional sports. They will produce anything of value to game players provided they feel they can sell enough units to make their time worthwhile and cover their expenses. (Ed) The ratings are correct for the teams listed. I had an erroneous listing of the bowl teams and that error was carried over into ASD. I knew it was incorrect but I did not know what the correct Sun Bowl line up was. To have corrected the mistake, gotten statistics for the correct team(Texas Tech) and done 'he research work necessary would have caused one to two weeks additional delay in that issue and I just could not cause any more delay so it was left as it was made-up. So you can not play the Sun Bowl until Negamco makes available the new 9 college conference sets, but you can play a good game between Arizona State and Georgia Tech or any of the other teams. These unlike previous year's bowl ratings are accurate 1971 Negamco College Team Ratings.
